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## NEXT STEP RESOURCE

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*Be sure you know the condition of your flocks, give careful attention to your herds. (Proverbs 27:23)*

How do I measure if group members are moving one step?

Ask! Make it part of your discussion whether in a group setting or individually. Here are some great questions to guide your conversation:

Tell me about your relationship with Jesus. Does your relationship with Jesus take priority in your life?

- If no, share with them your personal testimony and offer to pray with them that Jesus will be Lord of their life.
- Invite them to a Sunday worship service.

Do you attend Timbercreek Church?

- If no, offer to meet them on Sunday before service and sit with them.

Have you been water-baptized since you have become a believer?

- If no, encourage them to be baptized at the Water Baptism service on the second Sunday of the month. Invite the rest of your group to come for support.

Have you completed Starting Point?

- If no, encourage them to attend Starting Point. Remind them that it does not have to be done in order so they can jump in at any time! Offer to meet your group members there to attend the Starting Point events together.

Have you been to Encounter (if they are a new believer or recently recommitted their life to Christ)?

- If no, invite them to join Encounter. Introduce them to the Encounter Coaches or Team Leader and help them make that personal connection.

Have you identified your spiritual gifts? Are you using them to serve on a Dream Team?

- If no, encourage them to attend Step 3 on the third Sunday of the month and Dream Team Step 4 on the fourth Sunday of the month. Even if they have attended Step 3 before, it is fun to attend again to discover new things.

Describe your daily Bible reading. Do you use a Bible reading plan?

- If no, direct them to the First 15 App or other devotionals on the Bible App.
- Invite them to Growtrack on Wednesday nights at 7pm. Invite to sit with them!

Tell me about your prayer life. Do you have a time, place and plan to pray?

- If no, recommend the First 15 App.

Do you have relationships that offer accountability?

- If no, encourage them to find an accountability partner or offer to help keep them accountable.

Are you tithing regularly?

- If no, recommend that they take the Tithe Challenge and suggest that they listen to previous messages on tithing online.



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
